***As you may be aware, the Bremen Public Library has been working on plans to remodel the building, add an addition, and reconfigure our parking lot. This is a journey that began back in 2014 under Library Director Marsha Patterson and then continued by Library Director Kyle Burkett. For the last 2.5 years I've worked to bring these plans to conclusion, and we are one step away from the vision becoming reality. The handing over of architectural designs to a construction firm and work commencing.

That final benchmark is seeking approval from the Marshall County Council for a \$3 million bond. This is not necessarily an easy sell, as it will require the raising of taxes. For the average townsperson this equates to approximately \$23.10 per year for 20 years.
